(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities and ultimately serve the student community to be better prepared and explore suitable career opportunities within society.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) B.L.D.E.A'S NEW ARTS AND COMMERCE COLLEGE, TIKOTA, KARNATAKA, INDIA, the first Party is engaged in Educational Services.

- F) The First Party is part of and promoted by BLDE Association.
- G) At present the BLDE Association has honed and nurtured more 75 educational institutions ranging from High Schools to Professional Colleges which include Medical College under BLDE University, Engineering, Business Management, Fine Arts, Law, Education, Pharmacy etc. Today BLDE Association glows as one of the leading educational associations of Karnataka, conceived with a framework under the dynamic President and well known versatile visionary Shri M.B. Patil, Ex-Cabinet Minister, Govt. of Karnataka.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTHIN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

**CLAUSE 1
CO-PERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable coaching programs that are conducted by First Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall

supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between both would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge. The education societies imparting higher education strongly feel that one of their responsibilities is to organize skill development training for Graduate and under graduate students by the experts for their career development and bright future. Most of the students are from rural areas where there are limited sources of getting skilled and specific trainings. If these students are given in-depth skill training after understanding their talents, they can achieve bright goals.
- 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** First Party could give valuable inputs to the second Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully for any future trainings/programs.
- 2.3 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities as per the Vision statement of the BLDE Association which is "EMPOWERING THE RURAL YOUTH FOR FACING THE CHALLENGES OF THE WORLD". Following are some tasks intended to be undertaken under the R&D Activity to ensure situation based trainings.
- a) To identify the factors influencing career development and asses students interest, abilities, preference and abilities, strength.
 - b) To locate resources for career information based on localized needs.
 - c) To facilitate resources to achieve their goals.
 - d) To give the knowledge and skills they need to make future carrier decisions.

2.4 Second Party Minimum Tasks: Shall conduct the following to further accelerate the achievements,

- a) Conduct career counseling program and explain about skill development program in the college premises.
- b) Selecting the students who are interested in skill training.
- c) After selection start the training at college premises only.
- d) Setup Labs as per requirements at college premises.
- e) While training provide the course materials and handbooks.
- f) After completion of the training provide the certificates and place interested students in respective places.

2.5 First Party Minimum Tasks: Shall conduct the following to support the effort in benefit of the student community,

- a. Make all required provisions to setup 2 rooms to setup Labs and 2 classrooms for conducting the training as per the requirement. Minimum 1500 sq feet area is expected which shall include an office room and a reception area at the second floor of the building.
- b. Depute a person to coordinate with AICE Society. This person shall act as a single point of contact and co-ordinate day to day activities if any.
- c. As both the parties share a common vision towards the student community it is expected that under this MoU First Party shall provide arrangements as mentioned in section 2.5 a towards second party without any or very minimal financial implications. Thus any facilities to run the trainings like training rooms, nominal electricity charges etc. are expected to be accommodated or agreed by second party accordingly.

2.6 Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the passed out and final year students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready. This shall be majorly achieved by training as per guidelines set up by chief minister koushalya karnataka yojane (CMKKY).

2.7 Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements for at least 70% of the students as per CMKKY.

- 2.8 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein


CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, manuals, training materials, presentations, inventions, patents, copyrights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement shall be valid for a duration of 11 months or until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms. The First Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any termination of this Agreement shall only be conducted by way of communication, correspondence etc. Post 11 months this MOU stands null and void and shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations. (if any)

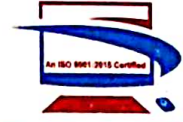

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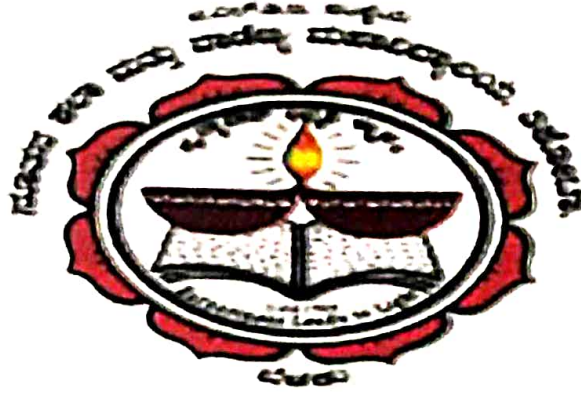
