

Abstract

Global Warming And It's Effects.

INTRODUCTION: Global warming means increasing the temperature of the Earth's surface (both land and water) as well as its atmosphere. In the last 100 years the world's temperature has risen by 0.75°C, about two thirds of this increase has occurred since 1975. Human activities are the main reason for the global warming.

CAUSES FOR GLOBAL WARMING: Main causes for global warming is the increasing of green house gases in the atmosphere produced by human activities like burning of fossil fuels, deforestation, establishment of modern industries ,adopting in modern agriculture system, development in technology and transportation and Urbanization these human activities produce large amount of green house gases (like Carbon dioxide (CO₂),methane (CH₂) Carbon Monoxide (CO)Nitrous oxide (N₂O), Nitrogen oxide (NO_x), Sulphur oxide (SO₂), Hydrogen Peroxide (H₂O₂),Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCS)) emissions which is causing global warming. These Green house gases are keeping the Earth's atmosphere in warm enough to sustain life. Without these gases the Earth would be too cool for humans, animals, plants and other creatures to live.

The natural greenhouse gases maintained the balance of atmospheric temperature. However when the abnormally high level of these gases accumulate in the atmosphere, more heat starts getting trapped and leads to the enhancement of green house effect. Human activities caused emissions have been increasing greenhouse levels which is raising the worldwide temperature and driving global warming.

EVIDENCES OF GLOBAL WARMING:

The following evidences are supporting for global warming these are;

- 1. Temperature records
- 2. Melting of mountain and continental glaciers
- 3. Warming of ocean water at global level
- 1. Temperature records: It has been started that the overall increase in the temperature in the 20th century has been About 0.5°C to 0.7°C. and 20th century has been recorded the warmest century in the last 2000 years. The last two decades of the 20th century i.e.1980's and 1990's recorded as a warmest decades since the systematic recording of temperature began in 1880. All the recorded ten warmest years have occurred since 1980. And last decade of 20th century i.e.1990 was recorded as a warmest single decade in the historical record of temperature, as seven out of ten warmest years occurred in this decade and 1998 was recorded as a warmest year of the millennium.
- 2. Melting of mountain and continental glaciers: These evidences shown that ice sheets of Antarctica and Greenland are breaking and the permanent ice cover of Arctic regions is melting, continental and mountain glaciers are shrinking in both size and length. The regular monitoring of Antarctica ice sheet has shown about 100 meter annual rate of shrinking. A rise






All the changes are generally associated with the economic development of the region. The Geographical review of dairy industry is to study the distribution of milk producing societies in the Geographic background. While studying the social, economic, physical and geographical, administrative conditions, the physical environment includes climate, soils, and the drainage pattern, also play an important role in the location in the dairy. The distributions of milk centers and the location of milk societies are analyzed. The dairy industry includes the production of milk its preparation for sale, to store and market, also it plans to develop the dairy industry. There are a number of milk products like butter, cheese, ghee. Excess milk is converted into powder and stored. There are many food products prepared based on milk. There is an important role of dairy industry on the economic growth of any region.

STUDY AREA

Rayapur dairy is located in-between Hubli-Dharwad twin cities and it is supplying milk to both the cities and also the other five areas viz, Dandeli, Haveri, Gadag, Shirahatti, and Nargund. The centre has got advantages to collect milk from the Dharwad district and the eastern part of north Canara district. There are 15 talukas in Dharwad indistrict covered under this dairy. The geographical location of Hubli-Dharwad region, it extends from longitude 74° to 76° East and 14° to 16° north latitude. The location of Rayapur dairy is convenient in the zone of the both the districts Dharwad an part of north Canara and the milk societies, it can be easily collect the milk, process and also distribute to the customers, the network of roads is convenient, but the distances is little more.
